Nomination deadline and procedures	Application deadlines: April 15 for Autumn semester / October 15 for Spring semester
	Please nominate your students by the deadline in Mobility Online through the online nomination form sent to you by Turku UAS. Turku UAS doesn't accept nominations by e-mail.
	The online application link will be directly sent to the nominated students via email after the online nomination has been submitted by the international coordinator. Incoming exchange students must complete the application in Mobility Online (including attachments) by the deadline.

Courses for incoming exchange students

Course registration	Incoming exchange students will register for the courses after their arrival.

Language requirements	No proof of English is required for students from partner universities. Level English B2 strongly recommended.
Course format and workload	At Turku UAS, studying consists mainly of different assignments, project work, lectures and presentations, and online learning and work in practice. In addition to independent study, you will also work in many different study teams and groups. Those groups may include other partners, such as RDI (Research, Development and Innovation) or company representatives. The above approaches to teaching and learning are part of innovation pedagogy (Innopeda) which is based on experimenting, sharing of knowledge and expertise, and combining different viewpoints. They enable the development of innovation competences, such as creativity, critical thinking and taking initiative. The average workload per semester is 25-30 credits. 1 credit (ECTS) = 27 hours of workload. We recommend incoming exchange students study 5 ECTS/month.
